The 2020 Birdy Dozen

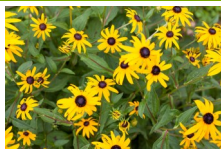

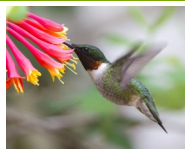
